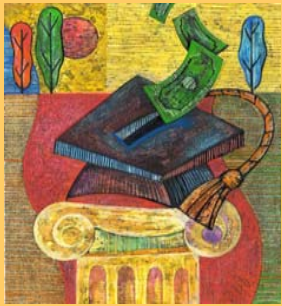


SCHOLARSHIP HISTORY



The UCC Undergraduate Scholarship Endowment Fund was established in 1994 by a

generous gift from the Society of the South Congregational Church of Brooklyn, N.Y. The Endowment is managed by Local Church Ministries of the United Church of Christ. The scholarship is administered by the Worship and Education Ministry Team of Local Church Ministries. *Awards are modest, ranging from about \$500-\$1,000.*

The Endowment provides scholarship assistance to members of UCC congregations who are under 25 years and are sophomore, junior or senior undergraduate students, in any discipline, attending an accredited 4-year university or college in the United States.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a member of a United Church of Christ congregation
- Applicant must be enrolled in a 4-year accredited college/university in the United States
- Applicant must be under 25 years of age
- Applicant is entering sophomore, junior or senior year of study
- Applicants entering their sophomore year may apply with a "C" average or equivalent; applicants entering junior or senior year must demonstrate at least a "B" (3.0) grade point average

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A completed application form
- Proof of university/college enrollment for upcoming academic year
- Proof of membership in a UCC congregation
- Official college/university transcript submitted by Registrar *including fall 2007 grades*
- Tuition/financial expense form
- Copy of most recent student FAFSA form
- Letter of recommendation from **Academic Dean** or **Academic Advisor**
- Letter of recommendation from **Local Church Pastor** or **Youth Director**
- 500 word Personal Statement



APPLICATION PROCESS AND PROCEDURE

Download your own application form and start the process today

Applications must be received in the Worship and Education office no later than May 18th

- Annual scholarships are awarded in June of each year
- Awards are remitted to the student's college/university for tuition expenses
- Students must submit an application each year for consideration
