Feelings and Attraction

Key Messages for Parents and Caregivers:

- Children learn about relationships and intimacy through family and friend relationships.
- Many young people develop feelings of attraction during puberty.
- Children may be thinking about their own sexual orientation during this time.
- People of all sexual orientations can have relationships that are fulfilling and based on respect and equality.
- People are often assumed to be heterosexual, which is called heterosexism.
- People are often mistreated because of their sexual orientation.
- You can foster a safe space for asking questions and having honest conversations with your children about feelings of attraction, where they will feel accepted and supported.
